Big Horn REA offices will be closed July 5th in observance of Independence Day.

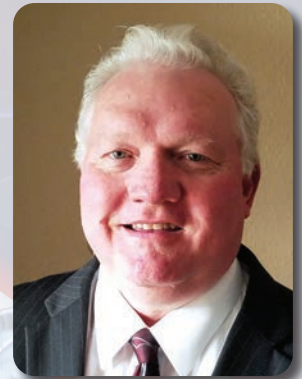
The Results Are In —

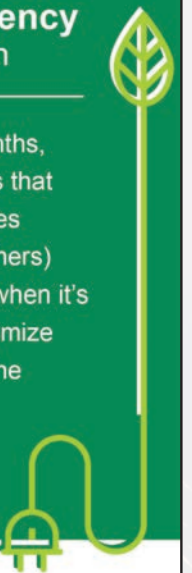
DISTRICT MEETINGS 2021

Ingredients:

DRY RUB

1 Tbsp Cumin	1 Tbsp Chili Powder
1 Tbsp Paprika	2 Tbsp Kosher Salt
1 Tbsp Garlic Salt	1 Tsp Cayenne Pepper
1 Tbsp Onion Salt	1 Tsp Black Pepper

MEAT

Your favorite Pork Rib

Directions

Rub meat with the Dry Rub. Smoke ribs for 1½ hours at 225 degrees. Turn, smoke for another 1½ hours. Wrap in foil for 1 hour. Unwrap and smoke for 1 hour. **Keep water pan full to keep moist.
